10-YEAR REVIEWS, SITE VISITS, ETC.**

**Accreditation Deadlines:** For 10 year reviews and any other Accreditation Site Visit requests (e.g., Satellite to Accredited Center) contact Carol Green for deadline information.

**Reminder:** Satellite Materials (see pages 32-34 in the Accreditation Manual) need to be in at least **45 days** before beginning a program at the Satellite center and a provisional letter must be received from the Accreditation Chair prior to recruiting students.

### **For Your Information: Accreditation Report Fall 2016**

ECR ACPE Supervisors, I hope you have all had a very meaning Thanksgiving season. I have just returned from the ACPE Leadership meeting where the Accreditation Commission was hard at work reviewing accreditation issues for our organization. I want to share with you some important information that you will need going forward.

- **Live Text is being replaced!** We have heard your voices!! The National Office has been responsive to the difficulties each of us has had with Live Text and is replacing it ASAP. Marc Medwed, ACPE Program Manager, has been on a search for the past few months that would allow us to continue to use electronic documents but without the complications from LiveText. During the Fall Accreditation Commission Meeting we were introduced to a **new platform: BoardEffects**, which we utilized during the meeting. We found it very functional and straightforward. The Annual Report for each center will be a fillable form on BoardEffects. Unlike the Appendix 1 fillable form from last year, this one can be saved and not lose the data. This one can be submitted from the BoardEffects site.

Each supervisor will have a BoardEffects account linked to their sign in to the ACPE website—no new passwords to learn! **The Annual Report** will be a fillable form in BoardEffects. It will be available by Dec 15. You can begin assembling your Annual Report information as a Word Document and then cut and paste the information into the form on BoardEffects. **More information to come by Dec 15, including information on a tutorial.** The BoardEffects Appendix 1 asks for the same information we have been submitting via the annual report and is

an easier form to use than Appendix 1 on the ACPE Exchange. Many complained about the Appendix 1 form last year.

**An updated version of our Accreditation Manual was published in 2016. Some items of importance:**

- **Late Final Evaluations: 308.8.1** Supervisor's evaluation will be available to the student within 45 calendar days of the completion of the unit. In unusual circumstances, the supervisor may negotiate with the student and receive approval from the regional accreditation chair to extend this deadline. The supervisor's evaluation will document this process and such extension must be reported in the next Center Annual Report. (see sections F and G of the Accreditation Manual)
  - **Notify Regional Chair right away**, stating: circumstances, the result of negotiating a new deadline with your students, and your plan to complete the evaluations.
  - Notify your Regional Chair when the evaluations are complete and send copies of the **new face sheet, Appendix 7D1**, along with a plan for ongoing compliance. If you follow this process, no notation will be assigned. The fact of the receipt of a self-report will be shared at the next Accreditation Commission Meeting.
  - If you self-report after you have given the students their late evaluations and submit a plan to maintain compliance, a notation will be assigned and removed at the next Accreditation Commission Meeting.
  - If no plan for on-going compliance is submitted, a notation will be assigned.

**Appendices are found in the ACPE Exchange: ACPE website → My ACPE → My Communities**

- **Face Sheets for Final Evaluations: There is a new Appendix 7D1. All Final Evaluations written by the Supervisor, the copy kept in the file and the copy given to the student, are to use Appendix 7D1 as the Face Sheet. This began January 1, 2016.**
- **Annual Notice:** Changes have been made to **Appendix 7B, Annual Notice**. Please review and update your Annual Notice by January 1, 2017.
- **Adding a Satellite Program: Requires a one person site visit** by a member of the Regional Accreditation committee within six months of the start of programs. (Section L in the Accreditation Manual.)
- **Application Face Sheets: Face sheets of all students accepted at your center are to be kept forever.** The final evaluations and other documents your center's policy includes in the students' records are destroyed after 10 years. When a Center closes, student records are sent to the National Office.
- **Processes for Postponement of 5 year and 10 year reviews:** Changes have been made and **handbooks and other materials are to be submitted in the year the review is due.** (section T in the Accreditation Manual) See:

- **Notations for Recurrence for the Same Standard:** When a center is assigned two or more notations for the same Standard within two consecutive years, consultation and a site visit at center's expense will be conducted by at least one accreditation committee representative. (Section G of the Accreditation Manual) See:
