It is 2015, and Joan Lyke just had a birthday, so good things ahead for us in this year.

I have flashed back 20 years or so and am an assistant basketball coach for the varsity girls' team at a local high school. Not much has changed in fundamentals and technique or actually in the athletes approach to the game, except they seem a lot smarter. I was warned that girls would be a lot different than the boys I had coached before. While that may be true I have found that as with CPE students if there is a relationship and you listen and want to connect and have their best interests at heart, they respond even if you're old enough to be their grandfather. As in CPE, connection doesn't happen unless you are interested and aren't just going through the motions.

What makes this team unusual is their head coach. She is a woman I've known a little for a lot of years. She is the wife of a friend of our family. She is in her 40's, was an outstanding college basketball player and has been a coach for a long time. She is an excellent tactician and practice and game coach. I have watched her play against men and overwhelm them with her toughness. Toughness comes in a lot of forms. She has been battling cancer for several years. She periodically receives chemo to keep it at bay. She receives treatment in the morning and has never missed a practice or game. She has occasional visits to the emergency room. She talks about all of it with her players' in a matter of fact manner and is slower some days than others; but always present.

So these young athletes are learning to be better players but more importantly they are learning what life, struggle and suffering are about and different ways to handle it. They are learning firsthand about living life to the fullest in the time we have and with the challenges we face.

Next week I head to the Regional Directors meeting for a few days. The agenda is very full as we talk about the changes the organization is facing and the proposals we will see in the New Year.

I just heard this morning that Versey Williams' father died after being admitted to Hospice. Send her your prayers and best wishes.

The Regional Meeting is Coming, Trace Haythorn the ED of ACPE will be joining us. It is an important meeting, join us.

**ACPE Standards & Manuals** are on a five-year cycle. The next edition will be published in 2015. Please check the Certification Commission section of the national website for interim changes. **Students in the certification process are responsible for updated procedures and policies. Please check the Procedures & Deadlines regularly for updated information.** For complete information on all Certification matters, refer to the ACPE Certification Manual and the Certification Policies and Procedures Manual.

**Note to Supervisory Education Students and Supervisory Candidates:** The ECR Certification Committee meets twice a year, once in February and once at the fall meeting, usually in September. A priority is given to applicants needing to meet a committee for a vote (Candidacy and Extensions), but we see Readiness applicants when there is space available.

**Supervisory Education Students (SES)** and others interested in the Certification process are encouraged to read the 2010 ACPE Standards and the 2010 Certification Manual to find out the latest in terms of what is required in the Certification process.

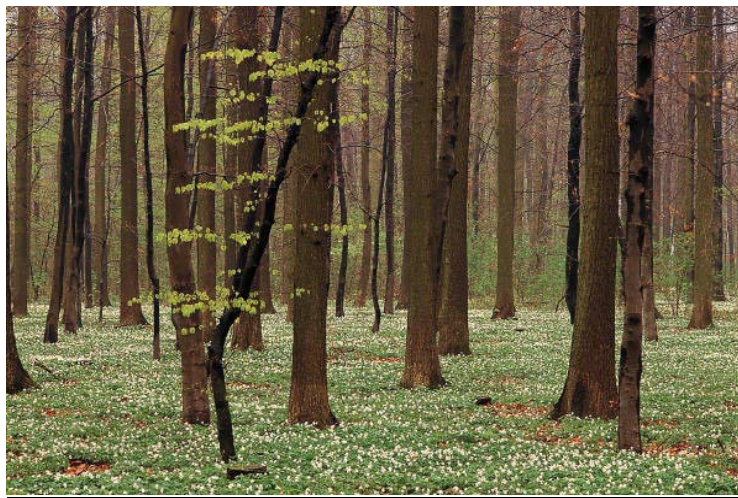
