Their goal will be to stimulate our thinking and dialogue. The bulk of each session will be devoted to small group dialogue. We hope to tap the collective wisdom of supervisors and clinical members. We look forward to discovering what we can learn from each other!

- **\*Seminars on Supervision (SOS)** - Everyone is invited to attend a Seminars on Supervision (SOS) coordinated by Frank S. Impicicche. Individuals in supervisory training will have an opportunity to present materials, personal issues or to schedule a mock committee experience with peers and supervisors from the region. These seminars are also a great opportunity for supervisors to share their approach and/or to see others work with those in supervisory education. [This seminar may be offered twice; to be determined by the number(s) of individuals signing up to present].

- *\*Workshop A: The Mysteries of Accreditation Revealed. Presented by Ruth Alpers. This workshop will introduce or re-introduce the essentials of the accreditation process. After a PowerPoint presentation, there will be time for questions. Rabbi Ruth Alpers is an ACPE Supervisor at Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical center. She is currently the Chair of the regional Accreditation Committee.*
- *\*Workshop B: A Community in Dialogue - Understanding and Assessing the Practice of Ethics From a Holistic Perspective. Presented by Yoke-Lye Lim Kwong. Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) emphasizes group learning. In this process, we commit to understand each individual student in relationship to her/his environments. We wish to engage the whole person of the student in her/his learning process. We intend our statement of ethical principles to guide us in the sensitive practice of CPE. This workshop aims to strengthen the relational aspects of both the student and the supervisor in communal dialogue from a more holistic perspective of ethics in ministry. Through the use of stories/clinical vignettes, metaphors, symbols, images, worldviews, we will seek to engage ethical dilemmas, controversies and questions that are intersected by race, class, gender, religion, spirituality, language and national of origin. Yoke-Lye Lim Kwong is an ACPE Supervisor currently serving at Community Howard health System in Kokomo, Indiana.*
- *\*Workshop C: Focus Interactive Time-Limited Group. Presented by Yvonne Valeris. The purpose of this presentation is offering a FIT Model for creating the kind of interactive, dynamic community where the group, rather than the CPE Supervisor, is the agent of transformation. Yvonne Valeris is an ACPE Supervisor, currently serving at the Christ Hospital in Cincinnati, Ohio.*
- *\*Peer Review: Although some individuals have peer review more often, ACPE supervisors are required to have a peer review every 5 years (Standards 411.6). Even though there is not a scheduled time on the program for Peer Review individuals may arrange a Peer Review at his/her convenience during free time or anytime during the year. If you plan to have a peer review, you will need to do some written work in preparation. The Peer Review Guidelines and report form may be downloaded from the regional website [www.ecracpe.org](http://www.ecracpe.org).*
