In case you missed the August 2013 ACPE e-Newsletter article by Claudia Meyer, Clinical Member Representative to the ACPE Board, Martha wanted to pass along the great news that there is a Clinical Members' Directory available thanks to the generosity of the Eastern Region (whose Clinical Member funds were used to purchase program), you can now access an interactive set of MAPS (by region) to locate Clinical Members by location!

The maps draw from information in a recent ACPE database of Clinical Members and plots the address listed for each Clinical Member in each region.
